



































The IDGs film





The Superhero in Me




Self-awareness

Develop self-awareness by exploring your capabilities and challenges

Prior to a group project, to get to know each other and be able to benefit from each other's qualities and strengths

Deep Listening



Empathy & Compassion

Learn to communicate about and reflect on the opinion, feelings and vision of others

Opening up to each other's perspectives, building trust in diverse groups

Positive Reframing



Optimism

Reframing from negative to positive for an optimistic attitude towards meaningful change
