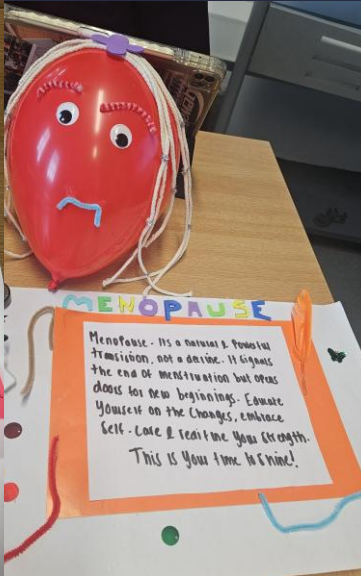
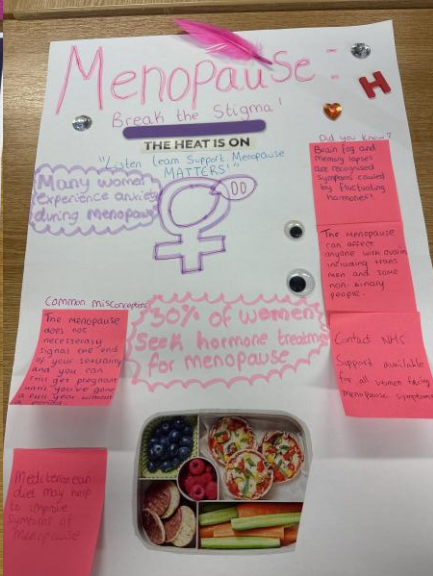
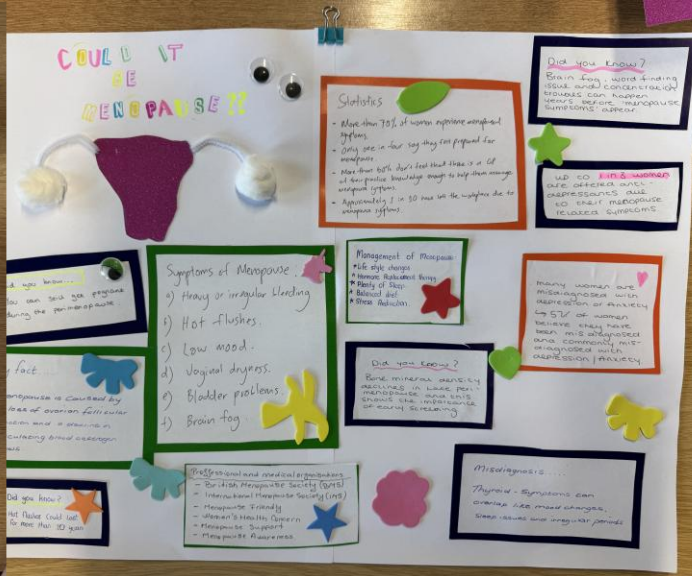
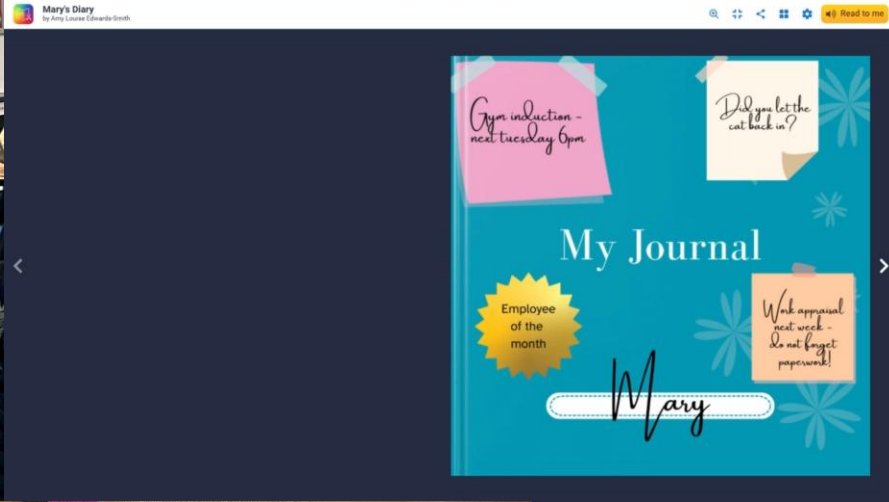
Working together as a group, rather than separating, is crucial to get to the end goal efficiently.

I have also realised the roles of other members of the MDT and their impact it was overall very beneficial

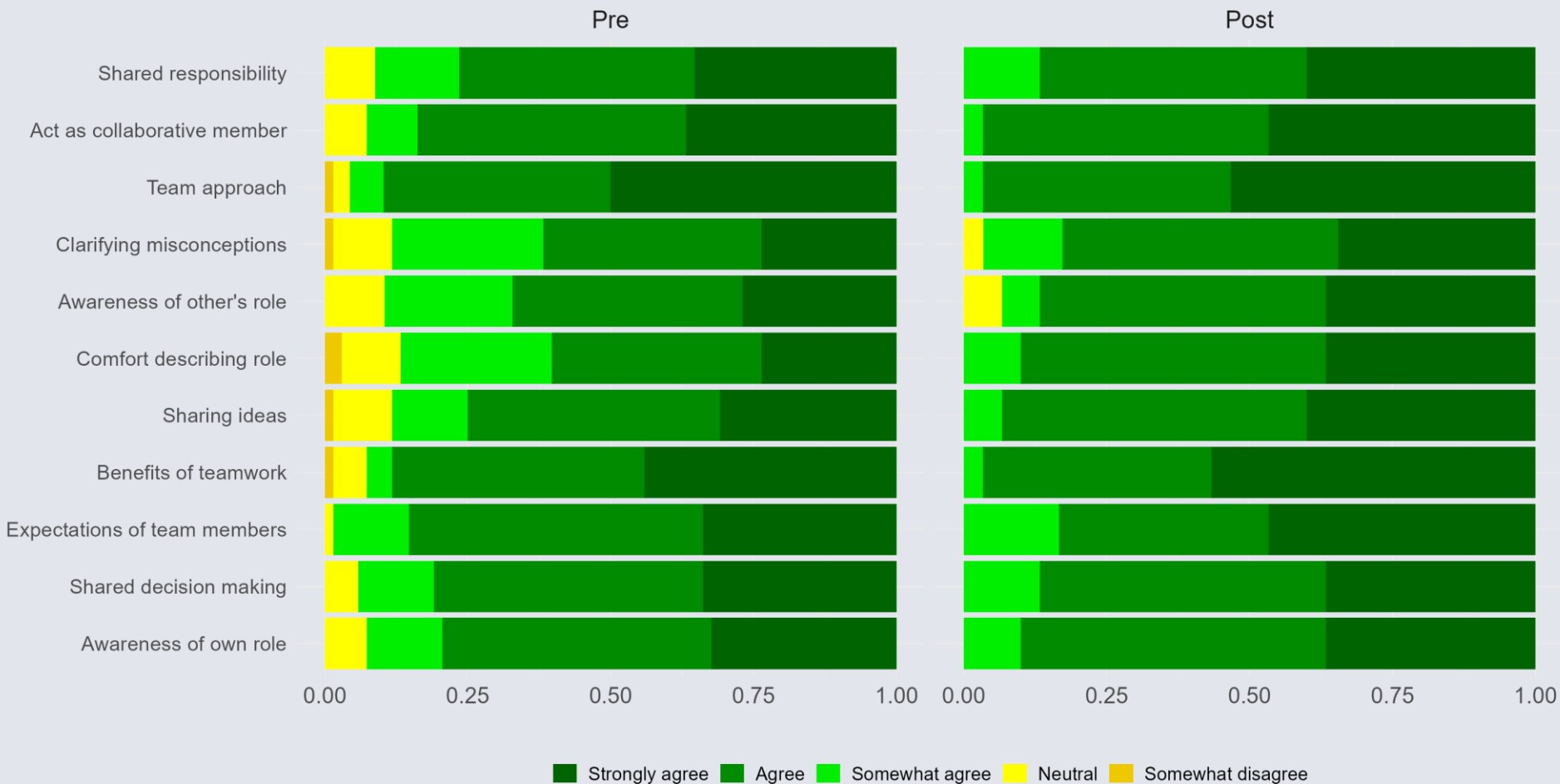
